Utility Dept.: Jacob Ashton was not in attendance at meeting


Police Dept.: Chief Medina still needs officer, gave statistic reports


Maintenance: Mr. Goodson advised he had sold both the dump truck and 2005 Chevy Pick Up. They have been filling potholes.

III. Those present included Council members Trayce West, Glen Vest, Doug Shaffer and Jason Gardner


Absent: Charles Cox

VII. New Business:


